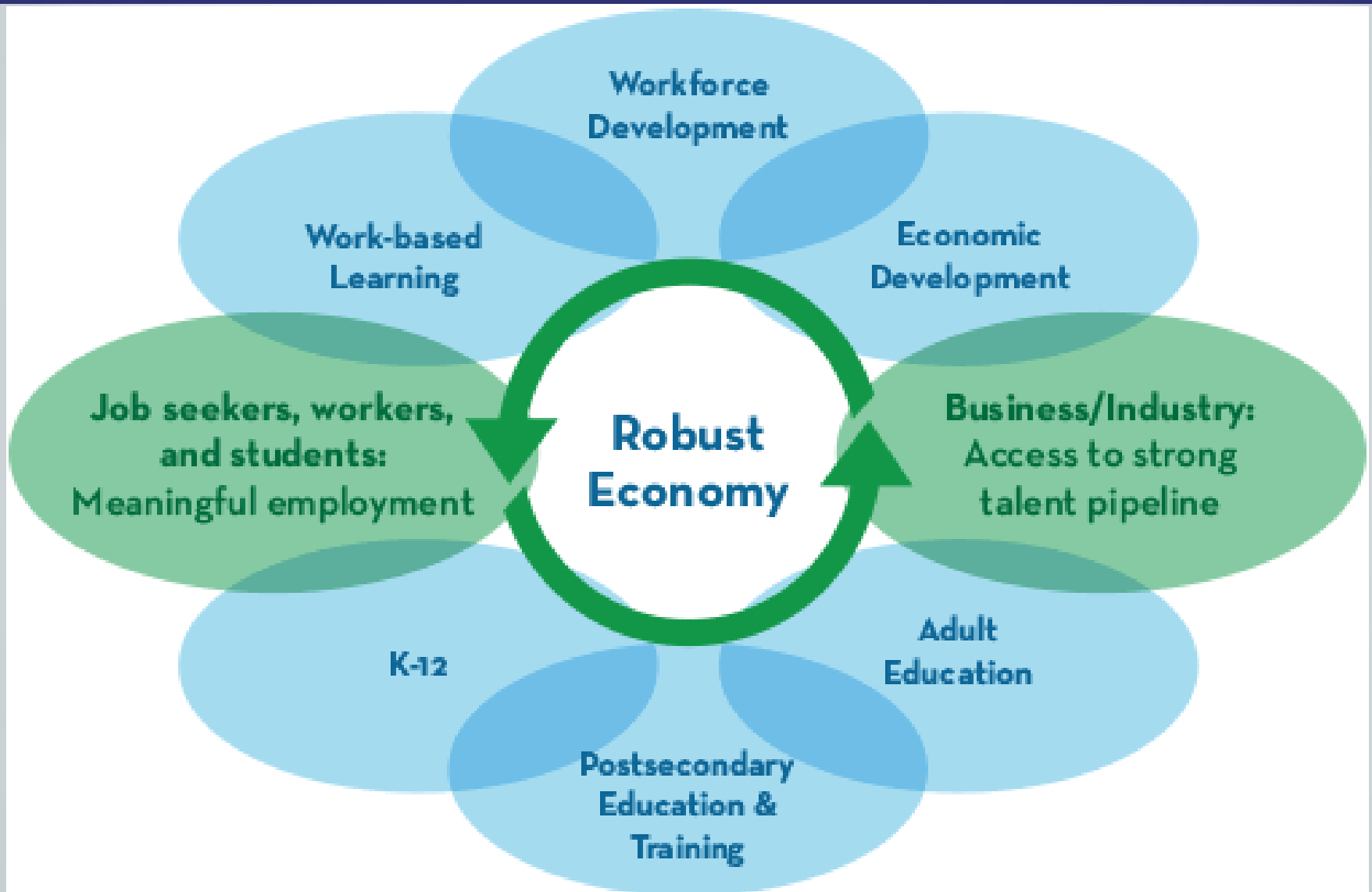

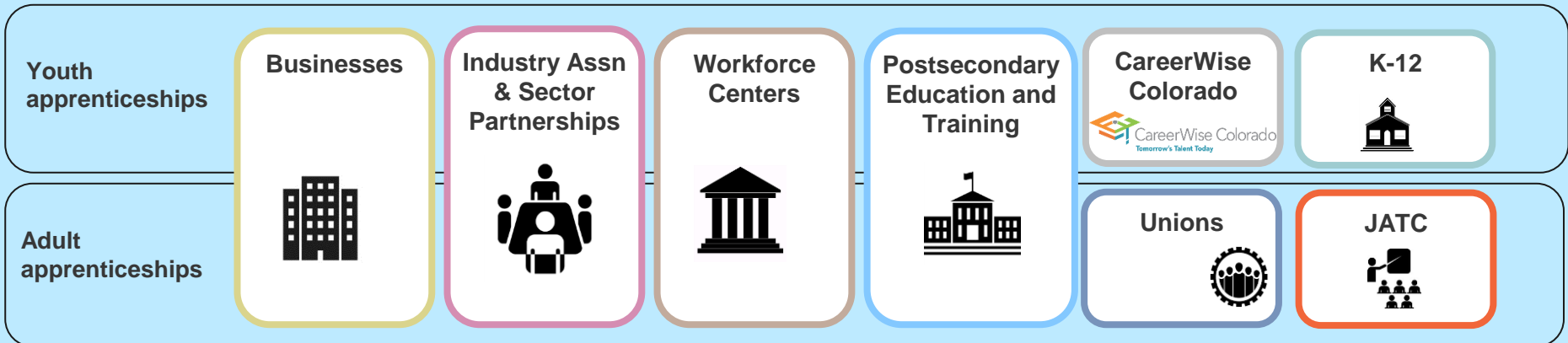
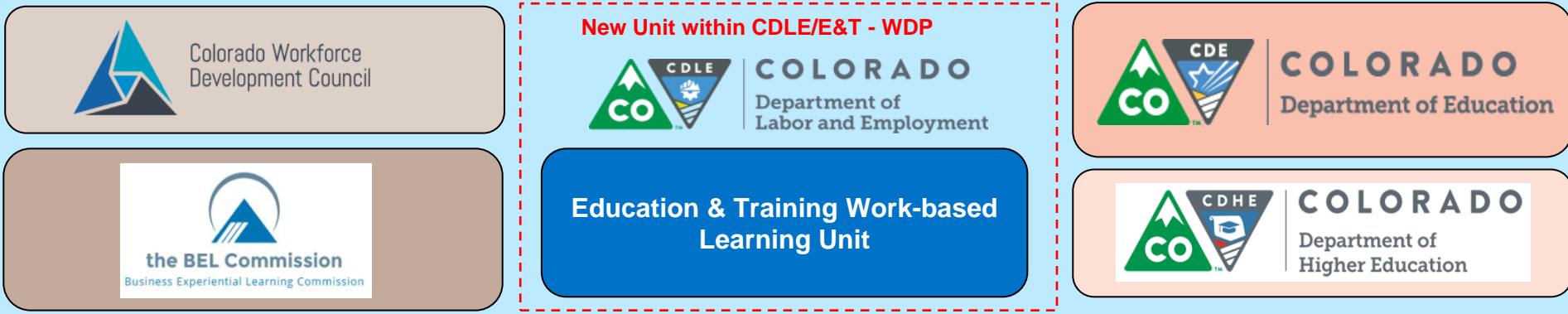

Registered Apprenticeships in Colorado

Strategies:

- Align with Sector Strategies and Career Pathways
- Adapt Swiss Apprenticeship Model for Colorado In-School Youth (Careerwise)
- Expand existing and develop new registered apprenticeship opportunities for Adults and Out-of-School Youth
- Develop competency-based registered apprenticeships in “nontraditional” high growth industries

State Role:

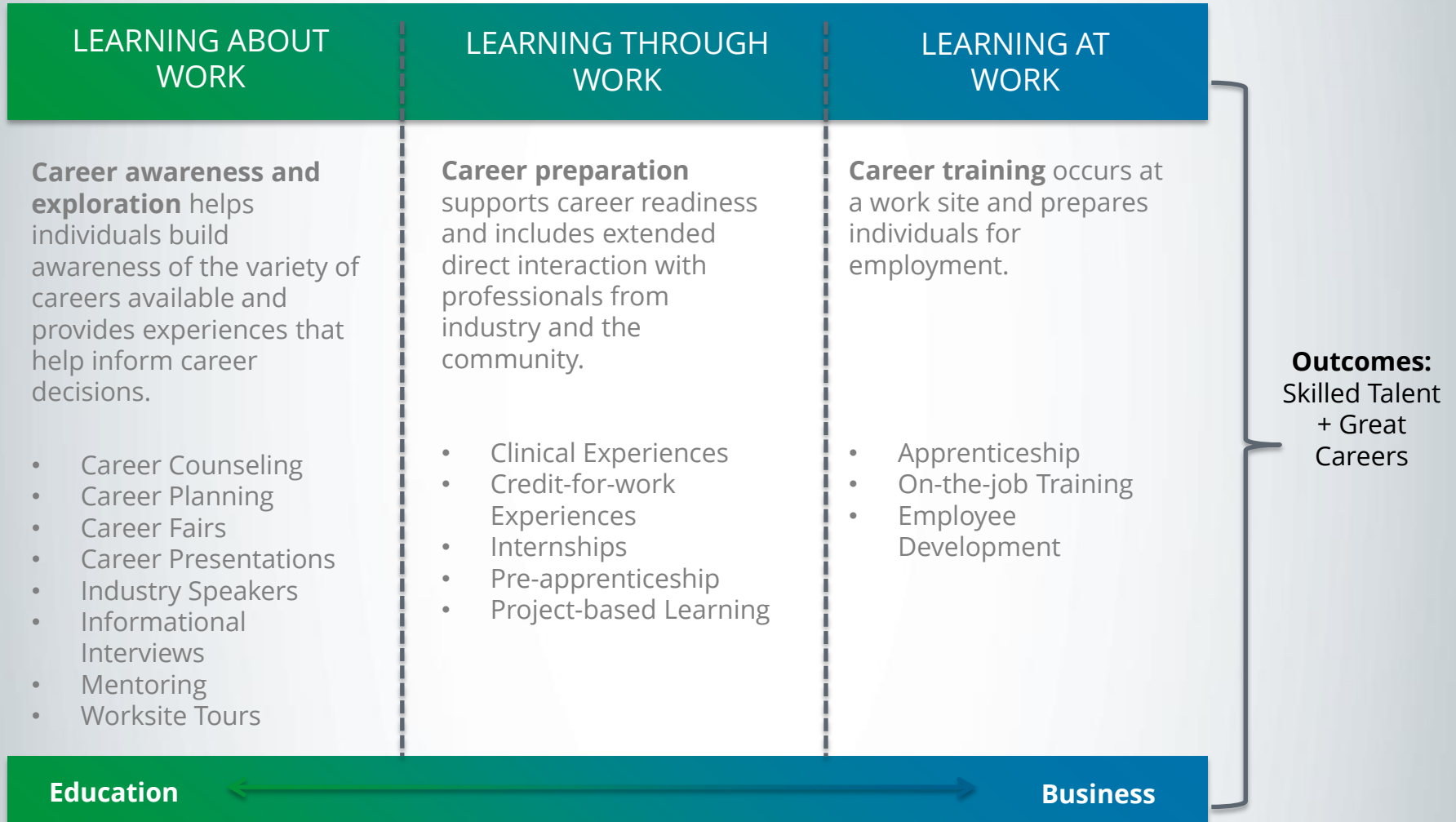
Provide technical assistance to local areas through building knowledge, developing resources, and streamlining state and federal processes

Local Area Role:

Use existing relationships/partnerships (sector partnerships, workforce boards, industry associations) to educate on and foster growth of registered apprenticeships in communities and regions
