Overview

NCPN is dedicated to serving its members and the career pathways community and in streamlining and strengthening the career pathways message to the field, across the nation and abroad. To that end NCPN has created the **NCPN Leadership Development Academy (LDA)**, a year-long professional development program designed to help career pathways practitioners develop *leadership skills* that will equip them to better serve the broader goals of their institutions, communities, and stakeholders. Participants typically include career pathways coordinators, CTE directors, occupational deans, workforce development personnel, adult education teachers, and counselors.

December 2019–October 2020, culminating at the 2020 NCPN Conference

How often do we meet?

Monthly via webinar and other technology-based means. All will be virtual except for graduation at the 2020 NCPN Conference, which will be held in Atlanta on October 15–17.
