



Economic Data: Unemployment, Jobs, and Earnings



In the Labor Force

Labor Force = Employed + Unemployed

Labor Force

 People within the working age (16 to retirement age) who are employed or are unemployed and seeking work

Employed

Worked (full or part time) during the past week

Unemployed


Individuals who actively looked for work during last four weeks

Labor Force = Employed + Unemployed • **Out of the Labor Force** In the Labor Force 15 years or younger 16+ years old **Currently working** Active military (Employed) Institutionalized Not working for one week but Not working and not actively sought work at least one seeking work time in the last four weeks (Unemployed)


State unemployment rates, July 2021, seasonally adjusted






Metropolitan area unemployment rates, July 2021, not seasonally adjusted




Employment Change Since February 2020 as of August 2021 Ranked by Industry Hourly Earnings


Earnings and unemployment rates by educational attainment, 2020


Adults doing at least okay financially, by education

CEO Confidence Outtakes

Consumers: Consumer confidence fell in August to lowest level since February – concerns about Delta variant and rising gas & food prices

CEO Assessment: 94% of CEOs report economic conditions were better compared to 6 months ago

Wages: 37% of CEOs expect to increase wages by 3% or more over the next year, virtually unchanged from 36% in Q1.
